

CONCEPTUAL AND SCHEMATIC DESIGN FOR ENTIRE FACILITY AND SORTATION SYSTEM CONTRACT DOCUMENTS, BIDDING, AND IMPLEMENTATION OF PACKAGE HANDLING SYSTEM Burlington Air Express (BAX) retained BNP in early 1985 to design a HUB facility to be operational in an eight-month period. The site for the new facility consisted of a partial apron and World War II Quonset Hut. BNP working on an accelerated schedule defined a facility and site, which enable BAX to contract the architectural, and building work six weeks after initiation of the design. The system contract was awarded approximately six weeks later for \$2.5 million. The first night of operation processed 1.2 million pounds of express freight within a 4-hour sort window.
